Metabo introduces its first nailer to the market. Completely without cable, gas cartridge and compressed air hose, the new NFR 18 LTX 90 BL unites maximum flexibility, power and comfort. “In our cordless nailer, we combine pneumatics with cordless - a technology that brings the best of two worlds together. Thanks to this, the cordless nailer has all the advantage of a compressed air nailer, but is cordless, does not require gas or a hose”, explains Metabo product manager Albert Werner. The new nailer is a real gain for the Metabo cordless range and the fastening technology. The tool is used wherever timber constructions require a stable connection: on the construction site, on the roof or when building a house.

Nailing with cordless power

The cordless nailer was developed for demanding applications on construction sites. It features a particularly high impact energy and an extremely fast firing sequence. With up to two shots per second, professional users progress quickly when working. “Our new machine handles up to 550 shots with one 18 Volt battery pack with 4.0 Ampere hours. This puts the cordless nailer on par with compressed air nailers, while it is safer and more comfortable at the same time”, explains Werner. Entangled hoses quickly become a tripping hazard with compressed air nailers, which is particularly dangerous when working on roofs. Furthermore, the gas cartridges must be replaced often with gas nailers. This causes extra cost, gas odour and explosion noise. “This can be remedied with our cordless nailer. It is safer, requires little maintenance, is more flexible and has a few more advantages”, says Werner.

Sophisticated system

For example, the NFR 18 LTX 90 BL has a tool-free driving in-depth setting. This permits precise working with different types of wood. Furthermore, it has two functions: At the touch of a button, you can easily change between single-shot mode and contact triggering for fast nailing in series. Another practical feature: The blank shot protection feature protects from unnecessary wear and increases the service life of the nailer.

Metabo also offers matching nails. For the new nailer, there are paper-bound D-head nails with a length of 50 to 90 millimetres and an angle between 30 and 34°. The nails from the Metabo range are available in performance classes one and two and conform to Eurocode 5. “The quality and safety of our machines and accessories are of top priority to us”, sums up Werner. “The new cordless nailer including accessories is the right choice when it comes to maximum free-dom, power, and comfort.”

The cordless nailer is equipped with the powerful 18 Volt battery pack technology from Metabo and complements the cross-brand cordless alliance.
